- Officers as Extra/Heavy Cavalry. The most senior Officer may be depicted as Extra/Heavy Infantry.
- Mid-Later Samurai may field an Army Standard mounted on the base of the most senior Officer fielded. If Warrior Monks are fielded, then a Sacred Standard may also be fielded, mounted on its own base, as a portable shrine carried by Warrior Monks.
- Troops from the Mid Period cannot be used with troops from the Later Period.
- Up to a quarter of all samurai bases fielded may be upgraded to Elite at a cost of +4 points per base.
- Mid Period Mounted and Foot Samurai may be upweighted to front rank EHC/EHI respectively at a cost of +2 points per base.
- Mid Period Retainer bases have front rank HI and back rank MI. They may be upweighted to all HI at a cost of +2 points per base.
- Ronin are masterless samurai. They may be upweighted to all HI at a cost of +2 points per base.

- The Later Period begins in 1465 when the first true professional Ashigaru appear, and many take to using the pike-like yari as their primary weapon. It ends in 1614 with the last pitched battle between samurai armies.
- Troops marked as OO* maneuver as CO bases due to superior training/control at a cost of +2 points per base (already included in Pts).
- From 1542 up to half any Ashigaru bases may be re-equipped with Arquebus (AQ) for +2 points per base. Arquebus (AQ): as HG but with Mtd BO range, +2 at short range.
- From 1542 any Samurai may count as (½SH) to represent their more technologically advanced armour in response to arquebus firepower, at a cost of +1 points per base.
- Later Period Mounted Samurai primarily wield katana or naginata, and then later still the yari, treated as a LA. A lesser proportion still carry longbows.
- Foot armed with LB or BO may be given ½SH in the form of ground-standing pavises at a cost of +4 points per base.
- Palisades may be purchased as Medium Works to cover the front of bases, at a cost of 10 points each. These are depicted on 6" x 3" bases, and may not be moved once deployed.
